### Location

The Montalembert has a smart Left Bank location for exploring fashion shops, antique dealers and designer furniture outlets. It's just 550 yards from the Impressionist masterpieces in Musée d'Orsay, or across the Seine to the Tuileries gardens and the Louvre. Yet is on a quiet side street with grand publishing house Gallimard almost next door. Rue du Bac metro is around the corner.

### Style & character

The Twenties stone façade gives the impression of a grand hotel, yet with just 50 rooms it has the personalised touch of a boutique hotel. Having stayed here before, it has to be said that the 1990 Christian Liaigre neo-Art Deco decor had been getting a little tired, so it's good to find that the revitalised Montalembert has become brighter and more refreshing. The ground floor has been opened up, adding a loopy totem-like book shelf that sets the tone in reception, yet keeping some Art Deco references with lots of wood and a lovely veteran cage lift that trundles gently up the daylight stairwell.
